1	Mathematical education training by using intellectual methods	This includes centers or institutes that offer education and mathematical training by using intellectual methods like teaching by using Fast Math Software (a program that trains on modern innovations in mathematics to perform functions such as addition, subtraction, multiplication, and division, as well as reviewing all arithmetic operations without memorizing) .
2	Computer software training	A training designated to design and, develop computer systems and computing environments, including the study to design, maintain, and integrate software applications. In addition to programming, analyzing, and designing systems, electronic data processing, network management, and programming languages (Visual Basic). Furthermore, it includes training on all computer applications, and this doesn't include hardware engineering or skills training.
3	Business and administrative systems training	Training includes planning, directing, and operating specialized administrative activities related to various institutions on matters related to business, finance, and administrative management. Furthermore, training includes managing a variety of operations and institutions such as educational institutions, recruitment processes, logistics management, administrative sciences, offices, theory and institutional conduct, employee affairs, and many more.
4	Professional and technical training	Training includes qualifying technical and professional staff to provide services or perform tasks and duties in various technical and vocational fields such as labs, workshops, assembling devices and equipment, performing technical support tasks, quality assurance, technical examination, and operation of medical devices and automated systems. Furthermore, this activity also includes training in plastic industries technology, carpentry, and blacksmithing.
5	Communication Training	A training institute that employs live methods by using the internet or other modern communication techniques instead of traditional classroom practices.
6	Radio, television, and press training	This includes training for necessary skills and techniques in the fields of radio, television, video film production, music recording, and the use of computer software that is relevant to this field. Furthermore, training includes theoretical and practical training for journalism, and press reports, as part of communication, in addition to activities that are related to the preparation of news reports, writing comments journalistic investigations, and many more.
7	Language teaching institute	This includes training on foreign language components, which consists of a foreign language that is taught as a second language. In addition to the study of cultures related to language, literature, and linguistics.

8	Accounting and auditing training	This includes training institutes that are specialized/ a part of its specialization consists of training on preparing special programs related to accounting and auditing and reviewing. It also includes registering financial transactions.
9	Educational consultations	This includes offices that are specialized in providing consultations and preparing educational studies for educational institutes such as schools, institutes, and universities ,or ministries and federations who are supervising educational establishments in the field of the school curriculum and means of enhancing educational institutions and planning education and training programs, testing and evaluation systems, education management, and the possibilities of collaborating with international or global educational institutions or other related consultations.
10	Support services for administrative training	This includes available establishments that are interconnected with educational institutes which provide training in all fields related to administrative work. These establishments provide and set up learning halls and connect them with the most recent means of education and other relevant services. Membership cards, and participation in training will also be provided, to aid the trainees and offer additional benefits. This doesn't include training and teaching on clients.
11	Training on standardized tests	This includes establishments that provide training services particularly in the field of tests which are required by various universities, colleges, whether they are in the country or abroad for individuals or students that are willing to complete their university education. Here are some examples on the kinds of tests the learner will be trained for: TOEFL-IELTS-CEPA-SAT-DASA CBSE BOARD EXAMS-AIPMT-AIIMS-BITSAT-IIT-JEE and other relevant tests or assessments. The establishment can conduct the test within its headquarters after receiving approval from the entity that is granting the certificate or by contracting with other companies to perform the test.
12	Music training	This includes educational establishments that are specialized in music education and training. Applicants will be trained to play all musical instruments and practice writing musical notes.
13	Applied arts training	This includes applied arts education such as painting and decoration, except for academic education that provides this type of education called school or classroom, etc. It provides formally organized learning from hobby, entertainment, or self-development, but does not lead to a scientific professional certificate or university degree.
14	Institute for training and qualifying teachers	This includes educational establishments and institutes that are specialized in developing and enhancing the professional behavior of teachers in terms of enhancing training and professional development activities and programs aimed at teachers. The institutes provide training programs aimed at preparing school leaders and teachers and qualifying them to improve the level of educational outputs achieved by students. Please note that all training materials are linked to efficiency standards in accordance with best international practices.

15	Office and secretarial work training	This includes educational establishments that specialize in training in administrative and office procedures and practices and specialized secretarial work and programs such as office organization, clerical skills, ,writing skills, printing, records organization, office machinery operation, reception and communication.
16	Translation training	This includes institutes specializing in written and spoken translation training in addition to training through the use of radio, television, the Internet and other means of communication.
17	Fine arts training	This includes establishments and institutes specialized in refining and sponsoring artistic talents through training courses in various fields of arts such as oil painting, painting, sculpting, graphic design and calligraphy regardless of gender (male or female), traditions and style, in addition to all elements of theatrical production management for a fee or without cost to the customer. Licensed commercial performing arts training centers are allowed to seek sponsorship funding and to achieve financial resources from multiple commercial sources such as entrance fees, membership fees, retail stores, rental of parts of facilities, as well as non-formal education programs, publications, and others. These centers can obtain a separate license for food and beverages and can be managed directly or with the help of external consultants. This classification also includes promotional and marketing activities for their services and activities such as advertising, public relations, publications, and other media resources.
18	Training in heritage crafts and handicrafts	This includes centers specialized in the teaching of heritage and handicrafts to preserve them from extinction, including wicker work, marine fishing tools such as fishing nets, pottery, traditional houses from palm branches, etc.
19	Hospitality and tourism training	This includes training for staff working in travel agencies on services such as making flight reservations or other travel means such as cars, trains, ships and issuing travel cards, in addition to how to deal with representatives of airlines and other travel agencies, tourism and renting services. It also includes other tourism activities, such as tourist guidance and learning relevant computer skills in the field of travel and tourism. Institutions that practice this activity do not grant any degree.
20	Education and hotel training	This includes training services for staff working in tourism agencies such as hotels, restaurants, and other relevant establishments. The training includes reception, accommodation booking, renting cars, accounting, and training on how to deal with guests.
21	Electrical appliances and	This includes technical institutes specialized in training technical cadres and qualifying them to perform services related to technical workshops for the repair of electrical and electronic devices, as well as installation

	electronics training	processes and procedures and technical examination to identify and report damage and how to repair those damages.
22	Sales training	This includes training to study the behavior of humans and their interaction within their social system, including training in various sciences such as humanities, crime, population, economic history, human races, human rights, peace and conflict, political economy, political science, psychology, social geography, sociology, and many more.
23	Fashion design training	This includes institutes specialized in training and offering studies related to fashion design, the design of fashion accessories, drawing on clothes design applications, and all the necessary requirements for fashion shows. The activity can also include training on all types of sewing for clothes.
24	Drone operation training	This includes all types of establishments whose work is concerned with evaluating theoretical and practical training services on remotely piloted aircrafts(drones).
